1. Data controller

3. Purposes of the processing and the legal basis for the processing

If you contacted us, we will process your personal data to:

- contact you to answer your questions. The legal basis for such processing of your personal data
 is our legitimate interest in having the possibility to reply to questions concerning our business
 activity.
- establish a business relationship and cooperation with you or your employer/the entity represented by you. The legal basis for such processing of your personal data is our legitimate interest in establishing and maintaining relationships as part of our business activity.

If you downloaded a scientific poster, we will process your personal data to measure the interest in our research. The legal basis for such processing of your personal data is our legitimate interest in being able to measure the interest in our activities.

If you expressed a wish to receive information about our activities by subscribing to our newsletter subscriber list, we will process your personal data to carry out direct marketing activities in the form of commercial information sent to the email address you have provided. The legal basis for the processing of your data is our legitimate interest in carrying out marketing and sales activities in connection with your consent to receive marketing content at the email address you have provided.

4. Storage period of personal data

If you contacted us, we will process your personal data for the duration of our ongoing relationship and after it ends, for a period of one year. After this period, we may contact you to enquire about the possibility of further processing of your personal data.

If you expressed a wish to receive information about our activities by subscribing to our newsletter subscriber list, we will process your personal data until you lodge an objection, unless the purpose of the processing ceases earlier (i.e. we cease to carry out direct marketing activities).

If you downloaded a scientific poster, we will process your personal data for a period of one month from the date you downloaded the poster unless you effectively object to such processing of your personal data earlier.

5. Data recipients

We will transfer your personal data to our suppliers to whom we outsource personal data processing services, such as IT service providers. Such entities process data based on an agreement with us and only in accordance with our instructions.

6. You have the following rights related the processing of your personal data:

- the right to access your personal data,
